"You all have access to viewing the proposed officer stipends, for the Panhellenic Council to be included as Section 11 of Article 4 of the UC Berkeley Panhellenic Bylaws. Thoughtful planning went into the design and allocations of the stipends; paying mind to the opportunity to create a more effective, sustainable budgeting practice. The decision to build and include an officer stipend model into the overall Panhellenic budget, is one in which we believe in strongly. We believe it will afford the community and council means for stronger officer accountability while simultaneously providing greater opportunity for those women to truly invest in their term - validating the volume and consistency of work officer leadership requires, while also hoping ease financial burden that a non-paid role of this kind can unfortunately create. Overall, we are hoping to get council approval of the proposed budget, but also approval of additions to the individual officer roles/responsibilities (included in the bylaws) articulating the individual stipend amount that is paid on the contingency that the officer has fulfilled the expectations of their role. Lastly, we find importance in moving into a model that support officer compensation to mirror our peers on the IFC. IFC officers have received stipends for at least the last 4 years - this practice is something the council has aspired to adopt for quite some time to affirm the work and progress women in our community have and will make."
